






Roth drinks too much to forget his demons, recent disasters have taken their toll, he is on a journey for redemption but he has not reached the state of blissful forgetfulness yet.

Her fresh hunger in search of a sparring partner refreshes his spirits, makes him flourish once more, and gets her going, reassuring herself she still has an impact.












BIO: Mike S. Ryan is a distinguished New York-based film producer with tremendous indie industry experience and a strong transatlantic link.

BIO: Johannes Rexin is a Berlin/Cologne-based producer with 30 years experience in the European film industry. Johannes has worked with distinguished directors on, among others, POKOT by Agnieszka Holland, HANNAH ARENDT by Margarethe von Trotta, ELLES by Malgoska Szumowska starring Juliette Binoche, BAL and GRAIN by Semih Kaplanoglu, and ANTICHRIST by Lars von Trier, starring Charlotte Gainsbourg. QISSA with Irrfan Khan was the first official European-Indian coproduction ever. His awards as producer, among many others, include a GOLDEN BEAR and a German Oscar (SILVER LOLA) for BEST FILM. Each of the films he entered at the Berlin International Film Festival won in their respective competitions.

In development and production, Johannes focuses on cooperation with select partners distinguished by their love for cinema and filmmaking.


Johannes is currently working on OBJETOS by Jorge Dorado, starring Alvaro Morte.

BIO: Volker Weidermann covers literature for newsweekly "DER SPIEGEL" and hosts the famous German TV show "Literarisches Quartett." For his novel "Ostende 1936," Sommer der Freundschaft," ("Summer before Dark"), Weidermann has done profound research, immersing himself deeply into the individual fates of Stefan Zweig, Joseph Roth and Irmgard Keun beyond the twenty days of seaside summer heat which make up the novel, and the film.

In his novel, Volker Weidermann connects contemporary history with the depiction of an unusual, passionate love and a similar friendship. He does so by condensing a panorama of each of the protagonists' lifelines into three weeks of their staying together at Ostend.



PRODUCERS NOTE,

"Summer Before The Dark" is full of fine humor and comic elements, a film about love and creativity, the characters being the "burnt poets", more relevant today than ever, deprived of their home, their language, and their hope.

Today in Europe, we have to again face reactionary nationalist movements in many countries.

Our film will focus on Irmgard: born in Berlin, a Cologne girl from
Braunsfeld, her books were burnt, and she was banned from writing.
Undeterred, she sued for compensation and professional recognition. After her father ransomed her from a Gestapo prison, she fled to exile when Hitler invaded the Rhineland...



PRODUCERS NOTE,

The result, Keun's sharp observation, "After Midnight," authentically reported from her own experience after 1933, is a merciless account of how authoritarian society destroys human relationships.

"After Midnight" is a masterpiece of maturity in expression evoked by the school of life. Our protagonists have to realize that neither their their abilities nor their talents can help them deal with the menacing development in Europe.

And they have to digest the double defeat of being existentially helpless and worrying sick about the future.

We want to create a strong film, a film that respects the dark moments of the individual fates in the novel as well as the dramatic conditions of creativity in exile yet never denies the sometimes absurd lightness of existence.
